LIBRARY NEWS

2017 is the 500th anniversary of the Protestant Reformation, led by the German monk Martin Luther. Seven books available for checkout in the church library deal with various aspects of Luther's life and times. One is a biography written specifically for youth.

These have been placed on the table at the west window for a quick look-over:

Brand Luther: How an Unheralded Monk Turned His Small Town into a Center of Publishing, Made Himself the Most Famous Man in Europe--and Started the Protestant Reformation by Andrew Pettegree. (The historian-author does not deal with Luther's theology in any depth in this book, but offers a revolutionary look at Martin, the Reformation, and the birth of publishing. Learn about the connection between printing and how deeply involved Luther was in the design and production of his printed works.)

Life-Changing Faith for Today: Why Luther's Theology Still Matters by David J. Monge
